Check the planting location for drainage before planting. If drainage is poor, please address first.

Planting Containerized Small Shrubs:

The plant must be removed from the container and planted with roots intact. If there is danger of the earth falling away from the roots, carefully cut the pot away. If the roots have spiraled in the container, pull them apart slightly before planting.

Dig a hole that is at least twice as big as the pot or root ball. Remove plant from container. Place the plant in the hole and fill in around the roots by using a mixture of 50% peat moss and 50% good garden soil. When refilling the hole, be sure to pack the soil in around the roots, leaving a small basin shape for holding water. At this stage, it is important that a root starter formulation of fertilizer be used (5-15-5). If a stronger formulation is used, damage to the roots may occur. The use of manure at this stage is not recommended because root burning may occur.

Determining How Many Plants Required for a Hedge

Measure the length of the area and divide by 3. Then multiply this number by 2. This number will give you the number of plants if you plant the plants 18" apart. Example: 30' long / 3 = 10 x 2 = 20 plants.

Dig a hole that is twice the size of the pot and follow the instructions for planting shrubs.
